

## WOODSTOCK COTERIE WINE LIST

Woodstock Winery is a small second generation, family owned Winery here in McLaren Flat. Our wines are designed to capture the essence of the region ensuring absolute quality all the way. This begins in our vineyards, through every step of winemaking, to the glass in front of you.

### **2009 Woodstock Riesling Estate Grown 6.5 25**

This Riesling was made from 36 year old Estate Grown vines planted on sandy soils in a north facing vineyard. To ensure we captured the delicate flavours of the Riesling varietal while maintaining its natural acidity, the fruit was harvested in the cool of night. Only free-run juice was used to ensure intensity and purity of flavours.

The 2009 Riesling is a delicate wine displaying citrus notes, grapefruit pith and a Granny Smith acidity on the palate. With its lean natural acid structure, it will age gracefully for many years to come!

### **2009 Woodstock Semillon Sauvignon Blanc McLaren Vale 5.5 22**

Planted in 1988 on rootstocks, this Semillon clone was specifically chosen for its tropical fruit character and zippy acidity. To ensure we get the best flavours from this variety, yields are deliberately kept low. Sauvignon Blanc sourced predominantly from selected cooler vineyards in McLaren Vale provide intensity and lift.

The 2009 vintage comprises of 96% Semillon and 4% Sauvignon Blanc. Gooseberry and passionfruit aromas abound. On the palate, Gooseberry with hints of tropical fruit flavours is balanced by a very crisp, dry, clean and refreshing finish!

### **2008 Woodstock Chardonnay Estate Grown 6.5 25**

Three clones of Chardonnay are planted on the Estate to ensure the right integration and flavour profile. The clones were specifically selected for their unique individual characters and were planted in mid 1970s.

A fruit driven style, we aim to capture the essence of the Chardonnay variety enhanced with only the barest amount of oak. Expect apples and pears with hints of melon to tantalise your senses.

### **2009 Woodstock Grenache Rose McLaren Vale 5.5 22**

Made of Grenache sourced from 80 year old vines planted on the Estate, the grapes are hand-picked and made to a style we enjoy at Woodstock. Free run juice is kept on skins for somewhere between 4 and 24 hours to ensure good colour. It is then cold soaked and fermented to the desired level of residual sweetness.

Aromas of sweet Cherry & rose petal invoke the senses to taste a red berry explosion of flavours with hints of strawberry. The 2009 Rose has a sweetness to it which is balanced beautifully by some crisp, cleansing acidity allowing this wine to be visited again and again.

### **2008 Woodstock Riesling Traminer McLaren Vale 5.5 22**

Woodstock Wines have been hand crafted by both Scott Collett (owner, vitculturalist/winemaker) & Ben Glaetzer (winemaker) as a team since 1999. They aim for absolute quality from the vineyard to the very glass before you.

Floral citrus blossom aromas greet the olfactory bulb and continue through to the palate. The Floral Riesling flavours are combined perfectly with Traminer (sometimes distinguished as Gewürztraminer). A classic fruity style of wine that seems ideally suited to spicy food as the semi sweetness cools the spice whilst the crisp acidity cleanses the palate.



## Woodstock 'The Stocks'

## Single Vineyard Shiraz

Named after a set of medieval wooden leg Stocks which stand in the town of Woodstock in Oxfordshire, England, historically used for the public punishment of the town folk who over-imbibed, "The Stocks" Shiraz is Woodstock's flagship wine. A replica of this leg stocks has been built at the entrance to Woodstock Wine Estate.

The 'Stocks Shiraz' is only produced in excellent vintages from the fruit of century old low yielding vines planted on the north face of the Woodstock Estate. This single vineyard which comprise of 31 rows, was planted in the early 1900's on sandy top-soil over a layer of clay on an ironstone base. The light coloured sand reflects the sun which guarantees optimum ripeness. McLaren Vale's typically warm days and cool nights, with sea and gully breezes make ideal growing conditions.

To ensure that this vineyard achieves maximum quality, the vines are inspected thoroughly during veraison. Exposed bunches are removed to prevent sun burn and the canopies reduced to ensure perfect ripening. Yields are deliberately kept low and the vineyard essentially dry grown resulting in intense concentration of flavour evident in this wine. The Shiraz fruit is harvested at night to capture and preserve the delicate flavours of the berries.

These grapes were then crushed, cold soaked for 24 hours before fermentation in small open vats. To ensure the excellent colour and ripe tannin structure so necessary for a wine built to age, each fermenter is hand plunged twice daily. The wine then aged in carefully selected French and American oak barrels in a temperature controlled room for 9 to 18 months. Each barrel is then tasted individually by winemakers Scott Collett and Ben Glaetzer and only the finest chosen to continue the lineage of Woodstock's flagship "The Stocks" Shiraz.

### 2007 Woodstock 'The Stocks' Shiraz

The 2007 'The Stocks' Shiraz is a complex wine with layers of aromas and flavours which continue to evolve in the tasting glass, and in the cellar. Pure fruit richness balanced with sturdy tannin structure will reward 10 or more years of patient cellaring as those layers open up.

**2006 Woodstock Botrytis Semillon (375ml) McLaren Vale 8 25**

Nicknamed 'Miss Dicky, The Sticky' this is one of our favourites in the Woodstock stable. Made from predominantly Botrytis affected Semillon but also Chenin Blanc and Riesling, this delightful wine is sure to win your heart. Aromas of apricot jam, glace pineapple, orange and mandarin peel set the scene for an explosion of luscious array of citrus flavours on the palate. Some nutmeg and spice is also detected ... a perfect balance of sweetness and acidity but finishing clean and leaving you wanting more!

**2003 Woodstock Barbera 'Recioto' Style (375ml) Langhorne Creek 8 25**

'Recioto' is an Italian word meaning semi-dried. It refers to the winemaking process where grapes are harvested and then laid out on racks to dry until they are raisin-like so that flavours are rich and concentrated. For Recioto wines, fermentation is stopped so that there is sweetness which makes a lovely dessert wine. The Barbera grape variety, which originates in Piedmonte Italy is a naturally high acid red variety very suited to this style of wine-making. Stewed plums, rhubarb and toffee nuances invite you to an intriguing palate of sweet and savoury flavours which linger. A great little wine to go with chocolate for those chocolate fans!

**2006 Woodstock Vintage Fortified Shiraz (375ml) McLaren Vale 8 25**

Capturing the essence of old vine McLaren Vale Shiraz, the fruit for this wine is picked when fully ripe, usually around 16 Baume. Red winemaking techniques transform the grapes into wine. Pure grape spirit is added mid way through fermentation to ensure a level of natural sweetness is preserved.

A huge and powerful wine with a great tannin structure, silky yet chewy tannins! Drinks well now but will develop complexity with age.

**Woodstock Muscat (375ml) McLaren Vale 8 25**

A highly perfumed wine made from white and red Frontignac grapes. Grape selection and degree of ripeness are crucial decisions to ensure a fabulous Muscat. Very ripe to the point of raisin development is desired to ensure lusciousness in the final wine. Long term maturation in oak adds complexity. An outstanding example of this wine style, displaying raisin characters on the nose with orange zest adding lift and a glimpse of Grandma's Christmas pudding making it an ideal partner for something sweet!

**Woodstock Very Old Fortified (500ml) McLaren Vale 13 45**

Traditionally known as Tawny Port, this wine is very special to Woodstock. A big portion of this blend was made by Doug Collett, the founder of this Estate. Like the Vintage Fortified, pure grape spirit is used to stop fermentation ensuring a desired sweetness level. The wine is then aged in small 200 – 300 litre oak casks. New wine is constantly blended to ensure consistency and freshness. Approximately 25 years old, Woodstock's Very Old Fortified is made from Grenache and Shiraz varieties. A rich and intense coating of toffee and roasted almonds makes this a rewarding finish to any meal!
